



Mastercard merchant rule 9.12.3:

“Maximum/minimum transaction amount prohibited. A merchant must not require, or post signs indicating that it requires, a minimum or maximum transaction amount to accept a valid MasterCard card.”

If you refuse to make the sale, I will write a letter to MasterCard informing them of the violation.



Page ten of the Visa merchant rules states:

“Always honor valid Visa cards, in your acceptance category, regardless of the dollar amount of the purchase. Imposing minimum or maximum purchase amounts is a violation.”
